Mandatory requirements for writing papers:

- the papers must be written in Romanian or English
- the submitted works must respect the theme of the conference and can have a maximum of three authors
- the title must include relevant and sufficient information in relation to the body of the manuscript. The title must be 10-20 words in length and must not contain abbreviations.
- the papers will be written in Times New Roman font, on A4 pages, with 2 cm margins
- the title will be written in capital letters Times New Roman 14 Bold, centred;
- the author and the institution will be written on two lines of the title: profession, first and last name, institution of origin, locality (Times New Roman font, 12, Bold, right alignment). Write each author's last name in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS (UPPERCASE).;
- start writing the **summary in romanian and english** one line after the author's name (Times New Roman font, 12, Italic), for the papers written in romanian;
- structure your abstract following this sequence:
 - Objectives.

- Material and Methods. Provide clear, coherent, precise, and verifiable data on the researched topic, sample structure, and evaluation criteria;
 - Results. Choose the most relevant findings, preferably expressed in numbers and statistically evaluated;
 - Conclusions. Main thoughts, limitations, and/or recommendations;
 - Keywords: list 3-5 keywords for indexing purposes; separate the keywords by semicolon; end the list with a dot.
- the writing of the paper begins with a summary line (Times New Roman font, 12);
 - the length of a paper must be a minimum of 3 pages, and a maximum of 6 pages (with the first page is the summary);
 - works in Romanian must be written with diacritical marks;
 - the content of the paper must cover aspects with a high degree of interest, from the topic proposed for debate within the symposium, have originality and include personal experiences;
 - the works received and which comply with the previously mentioned criteria will be gathered in a publication with an ISBN, which will be sent electronically to the participants;
 - abbreviations are NOT accepted in the title and should be avoided in the abstract. In-text abbreviations must be explained in parentheses (round brackets) at their first occurrence.
 - the responsibility for the content of the materials registered at the symposium rests entirely with the authors, which will complete a declaration in this direction;
 - the organizers reserve the right not to consider materials that do not meet the conditions set out above.
